9. Public hearing to consider amendment of the TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES ORDINANCE of the Code of the Town of Cicero to designate and provide for no parking at all times on the South side of Mud Mill Road across from Plank Road Park and the installation of the necessary signs therefore known as Local Law 6 of 2013
10. Move for the adoption of a resolution to reschedule the Public Hearing to consider a Zone Change from Industrial and Agricultural to General Commercial Plus for the property located at 5775 Sneller Road, Tax Map No. 120.-02-01.3 from June 26, 2013 to July 24, 2013 at 6:30 p.m.
11. Public Hearing to consider a formal abandonment of a portion of an undeveloped paper road described as the unpaved portion of Ontario Avenue from the south line of Lot 31 of the Island View Track, southerly to the intersection of South Bay Road. The proposed abandonment would release the Town's option to build a roadway over a portion of the reservation to the adjoining land owners to the centerline of the former proposed road. Also, the proposed Cross Avenue also shown on said map 84 of Island View Park filed 8/31/1923 as map number 1862
12. Consideration for the Town Board to move the adoption of a resolution to authorize the Supervisor to sign the Intermunicipal Wastewater Agreement between the Town of Cicero and County of Onondaga
13. Move for the adoption of a resolution approving the proposed "Agreement" between the North Syracuse School District and the Town of Cicero for use of the fueling facility located at the District's Support Complex at 5520 East Taft Road and authorizing the Supervisor to execute the same. The form and content of the agreement has been approved by the Town Attorney
14. Move for the adoption of a resolution to accept sealed bids for the lighting package and electrical services for the Riverfront Park project per the bid specifications as prepared by Saratoga Associates said bid booklet shall be available at the Town Clerk's office, County of Onondaga's Community Development Office and the Office of Saratoga Associates beginning on July 1st and sealed bids shall be opened at the Cicero Town Hall on July 17th at 10:00 AM, an onsite pre-bid meeting shall take place at Riverfront Park on July 10th at 9:00 AM for interested bidders, with said award for the contract being made at the regular Town Board Meeting on July 24, 2013

15. Move for the adoption of a resolution to approve the following for the Highway Department:
 - A. \$1201.65 to Vantage Equipment for repair to Volvo Excavator #45
 - B. \$1025.00 to Frank Murken Products for 400ft. of sewer hose for the sewer jet #93
 - C. \$4,377.25 to EPS Environmental Products & Services for additional fee to clean Highway Garage trench
 - D. \$2,623.25 to Crossroads Highway for guardrail for repair on Circle Drive W. - from accident
16. Move for the adoption of a resolution to provide additional funding in the amount of \$18,967 for repairs and replacement of the original Senior Center roof (section 1) and repairs to the Senior Center parking lot (south side) to be used in conjunction with the community development grant in the amount of \$30,000.00
17. Move for the adoption of a resolution to accept the Youth Services funds waived by the Town of Clay from N.Y. State Office of Children and Family Services in the amount of \$5,634 for the operation of the CanTeen
18. Move for the adoption of a resolution to approve the following from the Parks and Recreation Department:
 - A. Amount not to exceed \$4,000.00 to John Wojcik for Tennis instruction for multiple classes throughout the summer (via fees)
 - B. Amount not to exceed \$2,600.00 to C.S. L. Masonry for installation of pavers and masonry work at Central Park pavilion (\$1,000.00 from Pop Warner, and \$1,600.00 from the Town)

Move, the adoption of a resolution approving registration with the New York State Office of the Secretary of State for a "Designation for Service of Notice of Claim" pursuant to the newly amended Section 53 of the NY General Municipal Law. The purpose of this resolution is compliance with the newly amended law that allows for electronic filing of Notice of Claim forms that are litigation pre-requisite with the NY Secretary of State as substituted legal service.
20. Move for the adoption of a resolution authorizing the Town of Cicero's Town Clerk to sell E-Z Passes in the Clerk's Office and authorize the Supervisor to sign the E-ZPass On-the Go Retail Sales Agreement
21. Move for the adoption of a resolution to authorize the Supervisor to execute the 211 Waiver for Police Chief
22. Move for the adoption of a resolution to establish standard work days for elected and appointed officials, and to report the days worked to the New York State and Local Employee's Retirement System (RS2417-A for the 2 Judges)

25. Move for the adoption of a resolution to enter into executive session Pursuant to Public Office Law Section 105
A public body may only go into executive session if the matters to be discussed:
 - Will imperil public safety if disclosed;
 - May disclose the identity of a law enforcement agent or informer
 - Relate to a current or future investigation or prosecution of a criminal offense which would imperil effective law enforcement if disclosed;
 - Relate to proposed, pending, or current litigation
 - Relate to public employee collective-bargaining negotiations;
 - Involve medical, financial, credit, or employment history of a particular person or corporation, or matters leading to the appointment, employment, promotion, demotion, discipline, suspension, dismissal, or removal of a particular person or corporation;
 - Pertain to the preparation, grading, or administration of examinations; or
 - Relate to the proposed acquisition, sale, or lease of real property, or the proposed acquisition, sale or exchange of securities, but only when publicity would substantially affect their value
