5. **Public Hearing- Amendments to Cicero Town Code**

Public hearing to consider amendments of the Town of Cicero Town Code, **Chapter 66: Brush, Grass, Rubbish and Weeds** to add and expand the definition of **Rubbish** to the definition contained in Section 66-2, and to add the defined term **Rubbish** to the language of Section 66-3(A) **Duty of Owner** (after the words "and the lot line.."). The purpose of the proposed amendments is to clarify and expand language in the Code regarding the affirmative duty of landowners in the Town of Cicero to keep their property free from excessive Rubbish and Solid Waste.

SEQRA and Decision

SEQRA: Move the adoption of a resolution that the proposed amendments of the Town of Cicero Town Code, **Chapter 66: Brush, Grass, Rubbish and Weeds** to add and expand the definition of **Rubbish** to the definitions contained in Section 66-2, and to add the defined term **Rubbish** to the language of Section 66-3(A) **Duty of Owner** (after the words "and the lot line..") is a Type II Action for the purpose of SEQRA compliance requiring no further review.

DECISION: Move the adoption of a resolution (Approving/Denying) amendments of the Town of Cicero Town Code, **Chapter 66: Brush, Grass, Rubbish and Weeds** to add and expand the definition of **Rubbish** to the definitions contained in Section 66-2, and to add the defined term **Rubbish** to the language of Section 66-3(A) **Duty of Owner** (after the words "and the lot line.."). The purpose of these amendments is to clarify and expand language in the Code regarding the affirmative duty of landowners in the Town of Cicero to keep their property free from excessive Rubbish and Solid Waste.

- Move the adoption of a resolution to approve an estimated amount of \$30,000.00 to Shamrock Sewer Service, LLC to perform sanitary sewer manhole rehabilitation. Improvements will be completed for various locations throughout Oneida Park which is also within the Brewerton WWTP Service Area.

14. **Executive Session**

Move for the adoption of a resolution to enter into executive session to discuss a matter concerning proposed, pending, or current litigation

A public body may only go into executive session if the matters to be discussed:

- Will imperil public safety if disclosed;
- May disclose the identity of a law enforcement agent or informer
- Relate to a current or future investigation or prosecution of a criminal offense which would imperil effective law enforcement if disclosed;
- Relate to proposed, pending, or current litigation
- Relate to public employee collective-bargaining negotiations;
- Involve medical, financial, credit, or employment history of a particular person or corporation, or matters leading to the appointment, employment, promotion, demotion, discipline, suspension, dismissal, or removal of a particular person or corporation;
- Pertain to the preparation, grading, or administration of examinations; or
- Relate to the proposed acquisition, sale, or lease of real property, or the proposed acquisition, sale or exchange of securities, but only when publicity would substantially affect their value
